The program is being offered for male and female athletes in Grade 6, 7 and 8 attending Holy Cross School. The Okanagan Hockey Group provides the professional coaching.

The purpose of this program is to pursue athletic potential, build personal character, and to develop an attitude that hard work, and positive values, are assets each student can carry into all aspects of their lives.

The program will consist of 37 on ice and 12 off ice sessions running from October 2025 until May of 2026.

Academy Days will be:

Tuesdays from 8:45-9:45am. Students should be dropped off at Maclaren Arena before 8:30am and they will be transported to the school after.

Fridays from 1:15-2:15pm. Students will be transported to Maclaren Arena and then picked up by parents after the session.

Cost is \$1200 for the school year.

School insurance fully protects all participants.

Course Credit:

Each student will receive equivalency for Physical Education.

Assessment and Evaluation:

Students will be evaluated each term in the areas of on-ice and off-ice performance. This will include their work and effort.

- All students must provide their own set of full equipment
- The Holy Cross Hockey Skills Academy is open to both male and female players
- The program is intended for individual skill development. No teams are created and no formal games are played

Progression through individual tactics (one on one play, scoring techniques, offensive and defensive tactics)

Goalie Instruction (if needed) stance, skating, movement, save selection, rebound control

Equipment will be stored each Academy morning in our half container installed outside of the school

The Tuesday practice session will begin at 8:45 and end at 9:45am.
The Academy members will be dropped off by parents at Maclaren Arena before 8:30am. There they will change, practice, and then be brought back to the school by 10:15 am.

Friday practice session will begin at 1:15 and end at 2:15. Players will be driven to the Arena by the school van and picked up by parents by 2:30pm.
